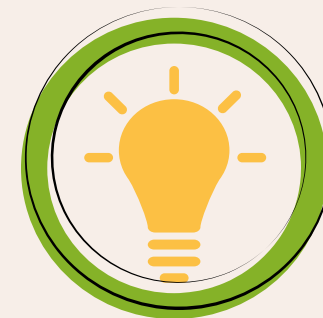


We used a range of devices well.



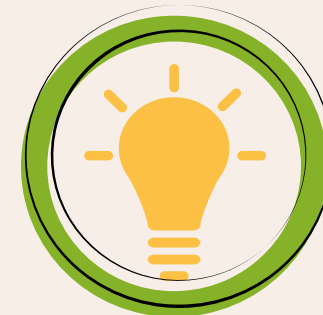
Our Pedagogical Framework showcased good learning and stipulated the way ICT supported and extended this.

We were clear in our vision for learning supported by the use of technology.



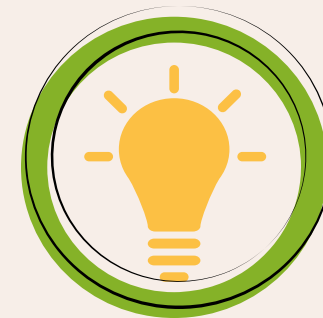
We were very collaborative with our community but also very assertive with the direction we were going to take and why.

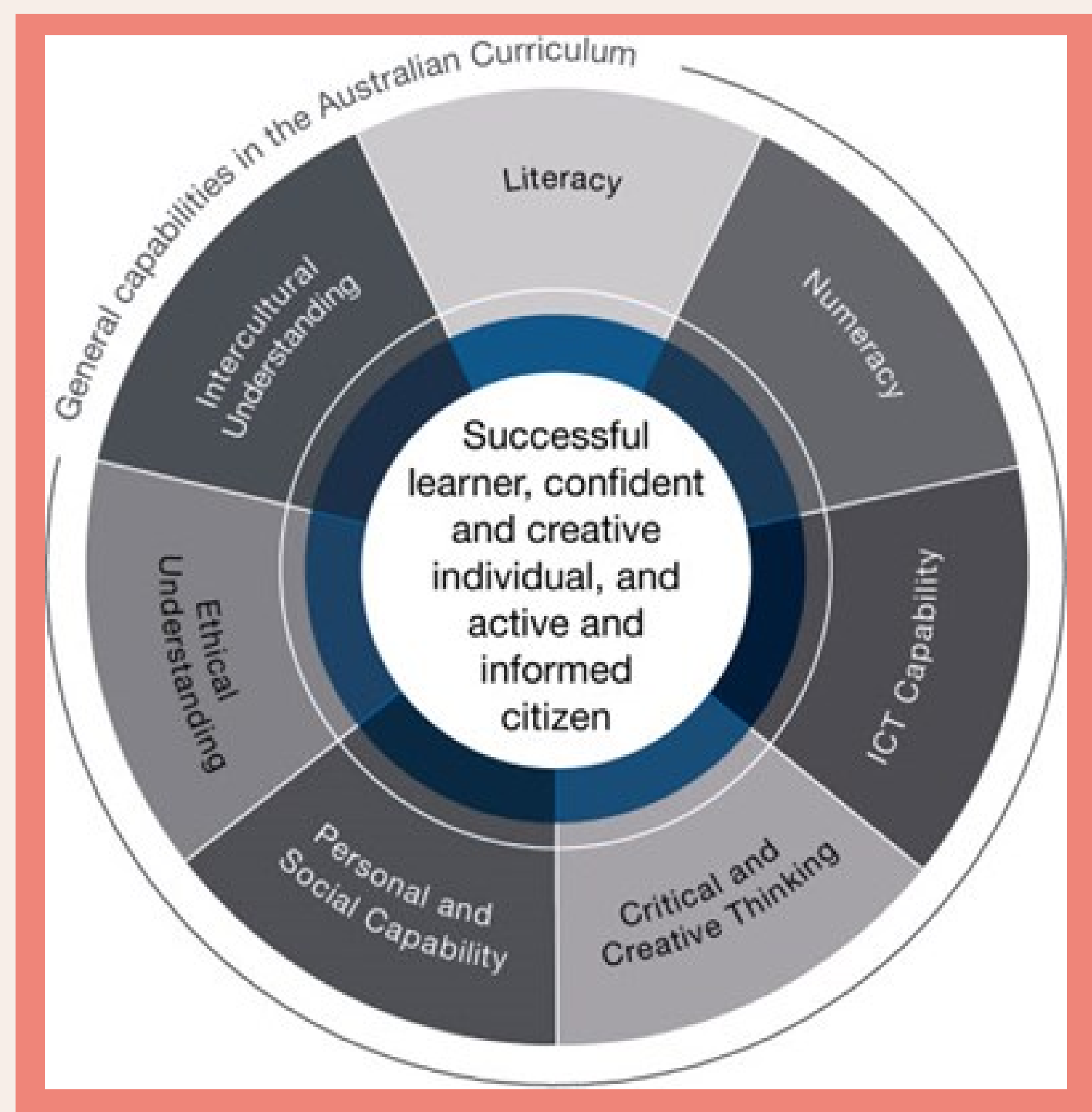

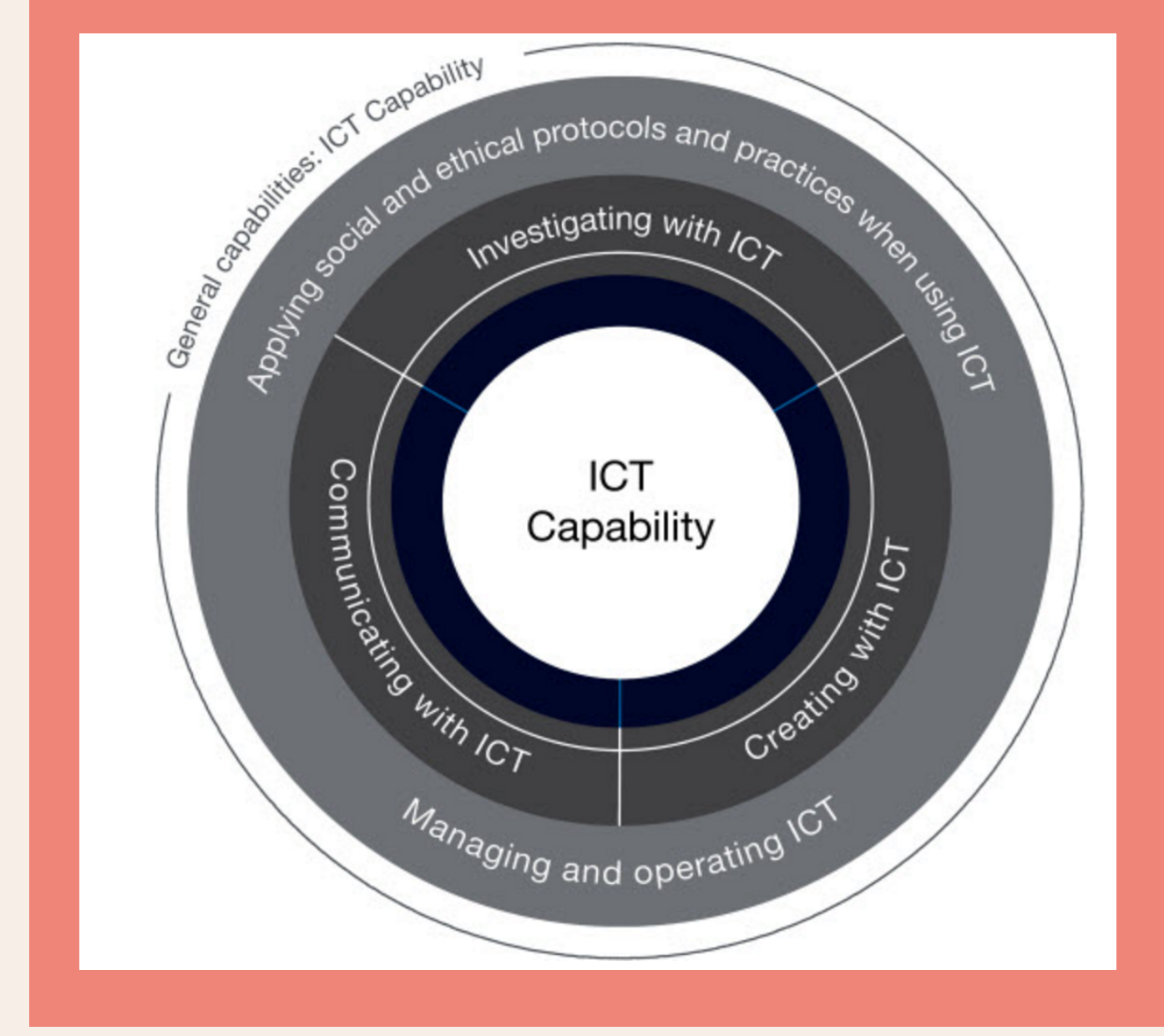
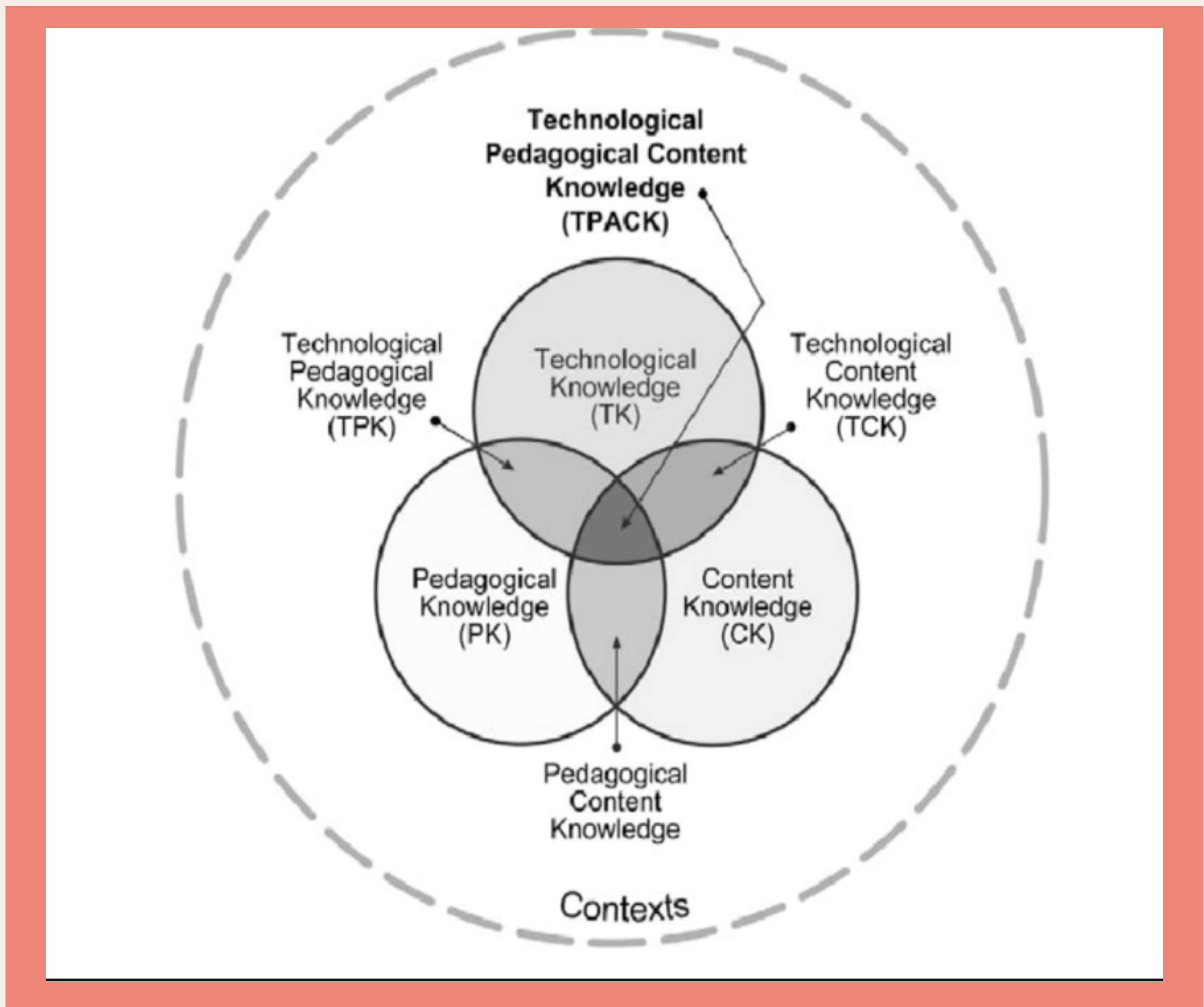

SAMR Model

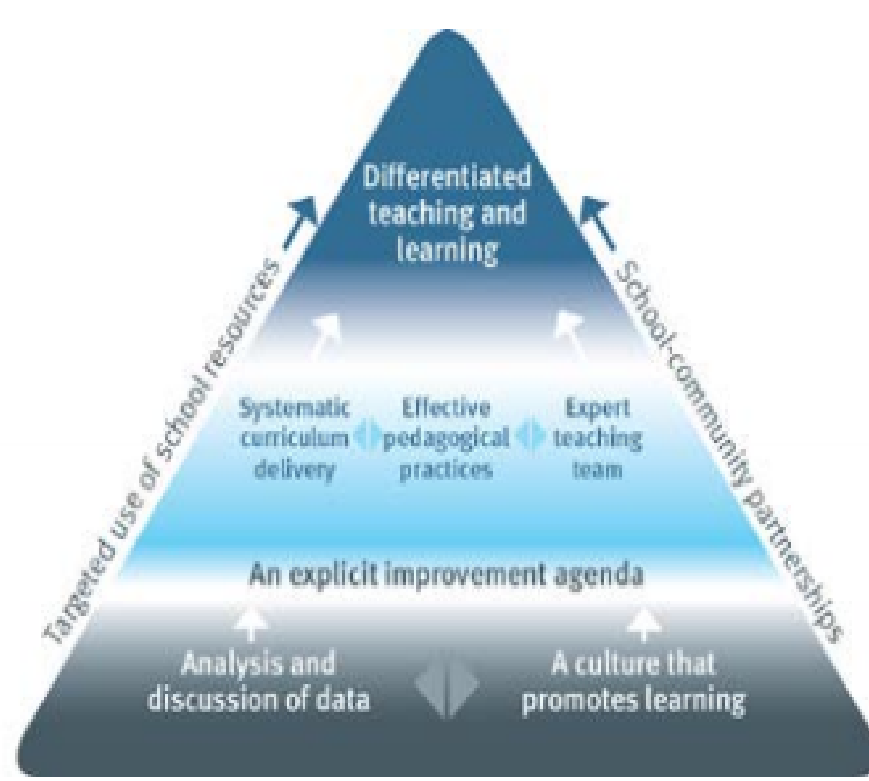

Very high	As implemented or revised within the school, the proposed measurable change can be attributed to the school.	Very high measured improvement.	As implemented or revised within the school, the proposed change can be implemented by others in a large scale.	Significant value from implementation and effectiveness gains.
High	Evidence from a high quality study or public evaluation that measurable change can be attributed to the school.	Large measured improvement.	Highly innovative solution.	Extensive value - information on the costs per unit of output gained.
Medium	A reasonably rigorous academic evaluation of the measurable change in the evidence.	Medium measured improvement.	Well documented.	Good value - information on the costs per unit of output gained.
Low	A high quality study that is relevant and rigorous, but does not provide enough evidence to attribute the measurable change to the school.	Small measured improvement that can be reasonably attributed to the school.	Some documented.	Low value - the value of the evidence for practice, research, teacher education, professional program learning, implementation etc. is low.
Very low	The school is unable to provide evidence that the measurable change can be attributed to the school.	Very low measured improvement or no impact is identified.	Not documented.	There is no value identified or the value is very low.

Phase 1: Foundations

What is your vision for learning? Has this been developed with all stakeholders? Is this clearly communicated and easily understood?

What is your experience with different forms of technology and do you have an idea of which device supports your vision and why?

How are the General Capabilities within the Australian Curriculum valued within your learning community? For this phase - ICT is particularly important. For future, consider Critical and Creative Thinking.

Who are the key people who will support the development of this phase?

Phase 2: Introducing

Do you have a plan for the initial phase of this project? Do you have your community's support and has the plan been collaboratively created with key stake-holders?

Have you chosen a device and have a clear vision for why? Does this align with your vision for learning?

What are the measurable goals you would use to help you define and achieve your vision?

Have you considered your infrastructure? Who can you receive assistance from to audit the current situation and assess your capacity?

Who are the key people who will support the development of this phase?

How will you support your families in the area of Digital Citizenship? Will this be viewed as a shared responsibility?

How will you manage technical support of personal devices? How will you support families to manage them? Is this a consideration?

Phase 3: Integrating

How well is the teaching and learning aligned to your vision? Is there a clear connection between both?
